#### Chinese Classes

### **Visa Application**

Students accepted by SHOU will receive an Admission Package containing an Admission Notice, Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW202), New Students Guide, as well as the Semester Calendar and Campus Map. With these documents students must apply for a Chinese visa (X2) at their local Chinese embassy or consulate.

## Pick-up Service

On designated days prior to registration week, SHOU provides pick-up service from Terminals 1 and 2 at Shanghai Pudong International Airport. Students who needs pick-up service are required to submit an official application at your personal SHOU account.
